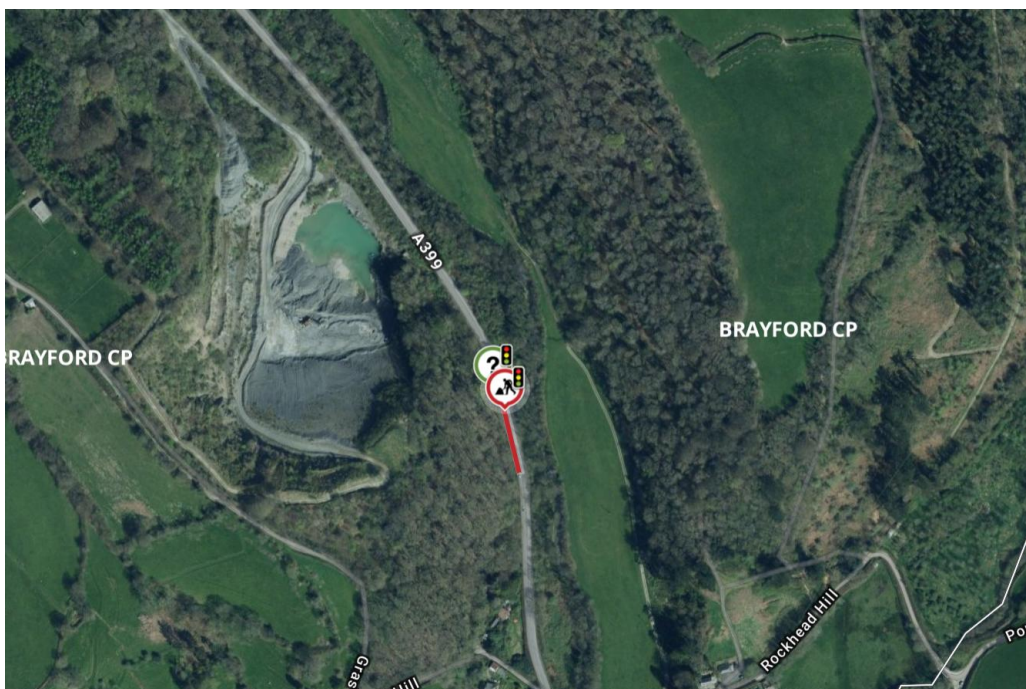
We would like to inform you about upcoming investigations on the above road.

These highway works are undertake investigations with regard to the cliff face on the edge of the A399 between Bray Barn and Newtown Bridge.

For safety reasons the road will **remain open** to through traffic although temporary traffic lights will be employed and there will be resulting delays. Please factor in extra time when using the road accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained, please approach operatives who will walk you through the site accordingly when it is safe to do so.

Any changes to the start date or duration will be shown on advisory signs on site. We will do our best to complete the work quickly and minimise disruption. Your co-operation and understanding are greatly appreciated.
